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Project Justification

Project Goal

Universities will play a highly significant role in educating future leaders and change-agents needed to address 21st Century challenges to the environment and community well-being.

Prepare university graduates as leaders who serve society, who live and work intentionally, positively affecting society, caring for the environment, promoting peace and understanding and respecting diversity.








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
