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






What is CATE?

- College student experiences that enhance the undergraduate academic experience and occur primarily outside the typical classroom setting
- Commonly referred to as co-curricular activities or high-impact educational practices
- Based on <u>Dr. Corey Seemiller's</u> work:
 - 1. Communication
 - 2. Intrapersonal Awareness & Development
 - 3. Interpersonal Skills & Intercultural Knowledge
 - 4. Ways of Thinking









Transformational Experiences are designed to:

- Foster intrapersonal and interpersonal development
- Help students determine their place in a global environment
- Provide students opportunities for humanitarianism and civic engagement
- Enhance students' communication, problem-solving, decision-making, analytical and creative thinking and organizational skills
- Help students realize their potential
- Improve student engagement and satisfaction
- Improve graduation and retention rates
- Prepare students for life after college

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Developed a CATE Tracking Database – Purpose & Goals:

- Track the transformational experiences of undergraduate students in the College of Agriculture individually, by graduating cohort, by category of transformational experiences, by department and by College
- Track student involvement by participation numbers and varied statistics (percentages of specified cohorts)
- Track involvement in specific, defined and verified categories of transformational experiences
- Encourage all undergraduate students in the College of Agriculture to engage in at least one meaningful transformational experience during their academic career



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
